What do the numbers 28+10=200=486 mean? No, it's not a secret formula or a combination.

Well, could be a combination...that lights-up college football scoreboards.

As teams in the Bowl Subdivision prepare for its bowl prepare for its season (and 1 game left in the Championship Subdivision) these sets of numbers indication the consistency college football teams since the 1885 season.

A breakdown shows:

- 28 teams in 2012 have scored 500+ Points;
- 10 teams have accomplished this feat for the very first time.
- 200 total teams throughout scoring history/500+Points
- With a total accomplishment of 486

The way teams have found the end zone in 2012; the numbers more than likely will jump even higher.

Currently, 10 teams are within 45 points of a 500+ season (2 for the first time).

Teams on the proverbial bubble include:

The 10 first time teams makes the fourth time (also in 2004-08-10) there has been teams recording a first-time season. The record is 13 set in a year ago.

Continuing with the theme of first time 500+teams; here's the all-time Top 10

Worth Noting: There has been 43 schools that was the overall points leader for a single-season...of that tally, 33 did so in their first season of scoring 500+ Points. Included was 4 of the first 10...the last first time team to record the highest single-season was Trinity (Texas) in 2002 with a total of 665 markers.

Minnesota, 1903-04-05, is the only college football team to lead the national in its first three season of reach this plateau. (This is also the "mark" for most consecutive seasons a team has be the highest-producing team.)

✓ Congratulations to NCAA II Valdosta State (GA) [582 points] and NCAA III Mount Union (OH) [792 points] on winning their respective division's National Championship—both schools are also high-scoring teams and have recorded several seasons in *Lighting-up the Scoreboard*.

Two other schools, vying to be #1 in their respective division have also scored at least 500 in 2012.

Sam Houston State (TX) has scored 587 points this season; and will be playing in Championship Subdivision's title game for the second year—against the same opponent, North Dakota State. In the BCS National Championship Game, Alabama enters the fray at 500 even.

A year ago, LSU also entered the same game with the same amount of points scored; but was white-washed by the Tide! ⁽²⁾
