

# *Lighting-up the Scoreboard*

**500 or more Points**

It's playoff time in NCAA II-III and the NAIA; with the battle in these respective divisions and for the right to claim the spot#1 begins this Saturday.

After the first two weeks as the lone 500+ team, Northwest Missouri now has some company—as 5 other schools topped-the plateau this past weekend.

In addition, there were 8 schools that finished the season by allowing at least 500+ points in 2011.

Highlighting the teams that have allowed 500+ was Faulkner AL, a NAIA school in the state of Alabama.

In its season finale, Faulkner won in triple overtime 95-89 over Union (KY).

The combined points—184—is the four highest of high scoring teams of all-time; and the first with both teams actually finding the end zone. All the teams above Faulkner scored over 200 points in their big win. (In fact, of the teams that have combined for the points shutout the opposition.) I am hoping to find the most combined points when both teams scored—if so, it will be presented in a future issue of “Lighting-up the Scoreboard.”
